

# OSACC 2020 Ontario Soybean Variety Trials

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Note: Due to COVID-19, The trials at Ottawa, St. Marys, Inwood and Woodslee were not planted this year.

The trials at Ridgetown and Exeter were planted, but will not be on the tour this year.

Please read any specific COVID-19 restrictions at the end of the each trial information section below before visiting the trials. For any trial locations that do not have specific COVID-19 information, please follow the regular health unit COVID practices: social distance (>2m), wear a mask if not possible, hand hygiene, and stay home if you are not feeling well.

## MG00E (2200) New Liskeard

New Liskeard Agricultural Research Station

New Liskeard

Temiskaming Shores, ON

GPS: 47.519079, -79.672302

From Highway 11, turn onto Armstrong St. towards Highway 65. Continue on Armstrong St. by going straight through the lights that allow you to access Hwy 65. A little over 250 m past the Hwy 65 lights is the field entrance, to the left. This gravel access road will curve to the right, then to the left. The trial will have signage for the day of the sponsors visit.

**COVID-19 pandemic requirements:** An email or call to let us know that you will be visiting the plot is required. We ask that you go directly to the field, and practice physical distancing. Please note that there will be no access to the buildings, including washrooms.

## MG00 (2400) Arthur

From the town of Arthur follow Hwy 109 (hwy 9) east to County Rd. 16 turn Right ( south ). . Plot is located behind the shed of the second house on the left. Signs will be posted at road.

GPS: 43.838581°, -80.456004°

## MG00 (2400) Dundalk

Take Hwy 89 east towards Shelburne, turn left at Dufferin Rd 17, then turn left on Line 4 (2nd road on right). Plot is in field on the right about 2 kms down. Look for signs at the road.

## **MG00-MG0 (2400-2600) Elora**

ELORA RESEARCH STATION

#6182 Second Line East, R.R. # 2

ARISS, ON

GPS at station entrance: 43.642019, -80.403829

The field is located directly across (northeast) from the station entrance. Follow the grass laneway across the road from the station buildings, and travel about 1 km to the bottom corner of the field, in the last field on your left before the second tree line. From the bottom corner of the field, the MG0 and MG00 Roundup Ready Trials are the first trials you approach located about 5 m northwest of the grass laneway. The MG0 Conventional Trial is located approximately 40m northeast towards the tree line.

**COVID-19 pandemic requirements:** Each sponsor is required to access the following plot visit schedule online and select a time slot for their visit:

## **MG0 (2600) Port Hope**

From the 401, take (exit 456) and head North. It will be signed at the road. Turn right on County 2 Rd. It'll be the first road you come to. Plot is at 7th house on the left also a Pickseed testing farm. Follow lane back to last red shed on right. Plot is behind red shed on the right. It will be signed at road

## MG0 (2600) Walton

From Exeter take Hwy 4 north to Kippen Rd. Follow Kippen Rd. through Seaforth to Blyth Rd. Turn left onto Blyth Rd, then turn right on to Brussels Line. Take first left onto Walton Rd. Plot is at first farm on the left. It will be signed at the road.

GPS : 43.684757°, -81.306661°

## MG1 (2800) Winchester

Winchester Agricultural Research Station

12088 Baker Road,

If coming from the 401:

- Get on ON-401 E
- Follow ON-401 E to Route 31 in South Dundas.
- Take exit 750 for County Road 31 toward Morrisburg/Winchester
- Turn left (N) onto Route 31 (signs for County Road 31/Winchester/Ottawa)

- Turn left (W) onto Baker Rd. Research Station building will be on the left. Soybean plots will be on the left, before you reach the Research Station building.

1.1 km

If coming from 416:

- Take Exit 34 to Kemptville from 416.
- Turn left (E) onto County Rd 43 (signs for County Road 43)

21.8 km

- Turn right (S) onto Route 31/County Rd 43 E (signs for County Road 31/Morrisburg/Chesterville)
- Continue to follow Route 31

5.4 km

- Turn right (W) onto Baker Rd. Research Station building will be on the left. Soybean plots will be on the left, before you reach the Research Station building.

1.1 km

Entrance to Field:

The research station main building is at 12088 Baker Road, on the south side of Baker Road. The field containing the soybean research plots is on the south side of the road, east of 12088 Baker Road. Field Entrance is at the same location as the OCC trials. When you are in the field entrance, take a slight left and the soybean plots start along the road. Signs will be posted.

Please pay attention to the plot stakes, as we did have a few issues while planting and we will move the stakes to the appropriate place (as noted on map).

### **MG1 (2800) Woodstock**

WOODSTOCK RESEARCH STATION

515216 Concession #11 (11th Line), Oxford County Road

WOODSTOCK, ON

GPS at station entrance: 43.144305, -80.786039

GPS at plot location: 43.141463, -80.801617

The field is located at the Woodstock Research Station at #515216 11<sup>th</sup> Line.

Take the gravel laneway opposite from the station entrance from 11<sup>th</sup> Line. Follow the laneway approximately 2 km through a series of L-bends. The Trials are in the last field on the right (North) side of the gravel laneway before the 10<sup>th</sup> Line, at the western-most extreme of the property. The MG1 Roundup Ready Trial is the last trial on your approach, while the MG1 Conventional Trial is located about 25 m east. Signs will be present. The entrance to the Woodstock Research Station is gated. **The gate should be open most days during station hours (9:00 am to 3:00 pm; Monday to Friday). For this reason, the visit to WRS is not possible on the weekends. Please plan your visit so you do not get locked out.**

### MG2E (3100) Talbotville

Take 401 to Colonel Talbot (4) South Exit. Head South through Talbotville to Sunset Dr. From Sunset Dr. turn right onto Fingal Line. From Fingal Line turn left onto John Wise. Turn right onto Bush Line. Follow Bush Line to Ashmore Rd. and turn left. Plot is about a Km down on the left. Look for signs at the road.

### MG2E (3100) Palmyra

Plot 101 of Roundup Ready 42.424298, -81.778088

Directions from 401:

- Take exit 109 toward Victoria Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 17/Chatham-Kent County Rd 21/Regional Rd 17/Regional Rd 21
- Turn onto Victoria Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 17/Regional Rd 17 (signs for County Road 17 S/Victoria Road)
- Turn left onto Gosnell Line/Chatham-Kent County Rd 19 (signs for County Road 19A/Highgate)
- Turn right onto Kenesserie Rd
- Keep left to stay on Kenesserie Rd
- After crossing Highway 3 the plots will be down the hill on the left

No trials will require prior announcement, though it would be appreciated if tour participants let Rob Brandt know when you did tour the plots. ### MG2L (3400) Chatham

Entrance to the field is across from 7035 Riverview Line Chatham Ontario  
Plot 101 of Roundup Ready 42.370197, -82.264931

Directions from 401:

- Take exit 81 for County Road 27/Bloomfield Road toward Chatham
- Turn onto Bloomfield Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 27 (signs for County Road 27 N/Bloomfield Road N) towards Chatham
- Turn left onto 5 Line E
- Turn right onto Dillon Rd
- Turn right onto Riverview Line
- The entrance to the field will be on your right as soon as you make the turn
- Drive along the ditch until the field is visible on the left

### **MG2L (3400) Merlin**

 Driveway Entrance: 42.257234, -82.190989

Directions from 401:

- Take exit 90 for ON-40/Communication Rd toward Chatham/Chatham-Kent County Rd 11/Blenheim
- Turn onto Communication Rd/ON-40 S towards Blenheim
- Turn right onto Cundle Line
- Turn left onto Charing Cross Rd/Chatham-Kent County Rd 10
- Turn right at the 1st cross street onto Middle Line/Chatham-Kent County Rd 8
- Turn left onto Drake Rd
- Once arrived continue down the driveway just past the house and the plots will be on your right side

## **MG2L (3400) Malden (Harrow)**

Take the 401 to the Leamington / Amherstberg exit. Take Howard (Hwy 9) South until it ends at Hwy 20. Turn right. Plot is after the second house on the left. Look for signs at road.
